EXTENDED DAY FAQ

What is “Extended Day?”

Extended day is an optional program that allows children to stay until 3:00. Days available: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.

Who can stay?

Extended day is open to children at any age, although the kindergarteners meet on Tuesday and Thursday for their own Afternoon Session, (separate enrollment application). In addition, they may enroll on Mondays or Wednesdays also. also.

What do the children do?

HAVE FUN!

The children from both classes join together for lunch and a planned activity relating to a particular topic. It is a wonderful opportunity for additional social interaction, as well as, group oriented projects.

What is the schedule?

At 12:00 the children join together in the front classroom, wash hands and begin lunch, usually beginning around 12:15 or so. About 1:00, the children begin cleaning up and get their special blankets & mats ready for rest time. Peaceful music is played and children may look at books quietly while resting. Rest time is about 20 minutes. The children then gather for a specially planned activity that relates to that particular day topic. Weather permitting; the children go outside for playground time.
